TRAINING AND COMPETITION ON THE COURSE

Control Commission

The Control Commission is located between the incoming and outgoing pontoons. The Control Commission will be in operation during all times the course is officially open.

Crew Photos

Team Managers will be notified of the athletes who have not yet had their photographs taken for the World Rowing athlete database. These athletes should come to the registration desk in the information center to have their photos taken during one of the following time slots:

Bow Numbers

Bow numbers should be collected by teams from the Control Commission located near the pontoons

Advertising

Please check the World Rowing Rules of Racing and related Bye-Laws to ensure that your racing uniforms and boats comply with the advertising rules

TRAINING AND COMPETITION ON THE COURSE

Boat Weighing

The boat weighing station will be located in the center of the athlete's area. You can refer to the map at the end of the document.

Test scales will be available from Thursday 18 May, at all times that the venue is open, except during racing.

Athlete Weighing

The athlete weighing station will be located in the club's weight room (see site map at the end of this document). Test scales will be available from Thursday 18 May, during opening hours of the venue.

TEAM FACILITIES AND SERVICES

Boat storage

The boat racks are situated on the synthetic pitch. The Organizing Committee will assign boat racks for all boats. Teams are responsible for their boats to be safely tied to the racks and are in no risk to be damaged due to adverse weather conditions.

Launch pontoons

There are two outgoing and two incoming pontoons.

Boat Repair

The boat repair services are located on the synthetic pitch and/or close to it.

Boat Washing

No chemical detergents or other sources of environmental pollutants should be used during boat washing. The boat washing area is located on the synthetic pitch.

Ergometers

Ergometers for training and warming up or cooling down will be provided – see the map of the venue. Each athlete must disinfect the equipment before and after use.

Team tent area

In case you want to bring your own tent, please indicate the dimensions and further details to the Organizing Committee (ercu19@csnbrive.fr).

TEAM FACILITIES AND SERVICES

Sanitary facilities/toilets

Showers and changing rooms will be at the club.

There will be toilets in the boat park area as well as in the changing rooms.

Cooling baths

There is no possibility to use cooling baths at the venue.

Bag storage

There will be a secure area next to the club and changing rooms for the storage of athletes' bags.

The bag drop-off will be open during the official opening hours of the course.

Rest area

The rest area is in the tent located in front of the club's boathouses

Viewing for Athletes

Athletes can watch the races from the grandstands on the beach next to the finishing tower.

Coaches Viewing

It is possible to follow the races on the path around the lake.

(Please note that the path will also be open to pedestrians)

MEDICAL FACILITIES AND SERVICES

Rescue and safety

There will be an on-water rescue team in charge of on-water rescue during official hours of the regatta course.

One ambulance will be on duty at the first aid station.

Doping Control

The Doping Control Centre is located in the Medical Centre above close to the finishing tower. All doping control tests will be conducted in accordance with WADA and World Rowing requirements. For all information about the Anti-Doping controls and procedures, please refer to the World Anti-Doping Code and International Standards available on the website www.wada-ama.org and the WR Anti-Doping Bye-Laws. Team Vehicles and Parking

Boat trailers

Trailers must be unloaded in the parking lot for towing vehicles. Boats must be brought to the boat park, on foot, following the path. No trailers may be brought into the athletes' area.

CREW REGISTRATION

WADA and Commitment Forms

All competitors and team officials, who have not already done so, are required to sign the World Rowing Commitment Form and WADA Consent Forms. These forms will be distributed to the Teams by World Rowing and should be returned to the OC volunteer in the Accreditation Office, before the Draw, and to a European Rowing Board Member in the European Rowing Office after the Draw.

Crew Changes

Team Managers are requested to check the entry forms by 14:00 hrs on Friday 19 May (3 hours before the Draw). If there are changes in the crews or differences in the spelling of the names, they must complete a Crew Change Form and submit it to the Organising Committee representative in the Accreditation Office before the draw. Crew changes *after* the draw should be submitted to a European Rowing Board Member in the European Rowing Office. For medical substitutions and withdrawals, please contact the World Rowing Doctor.

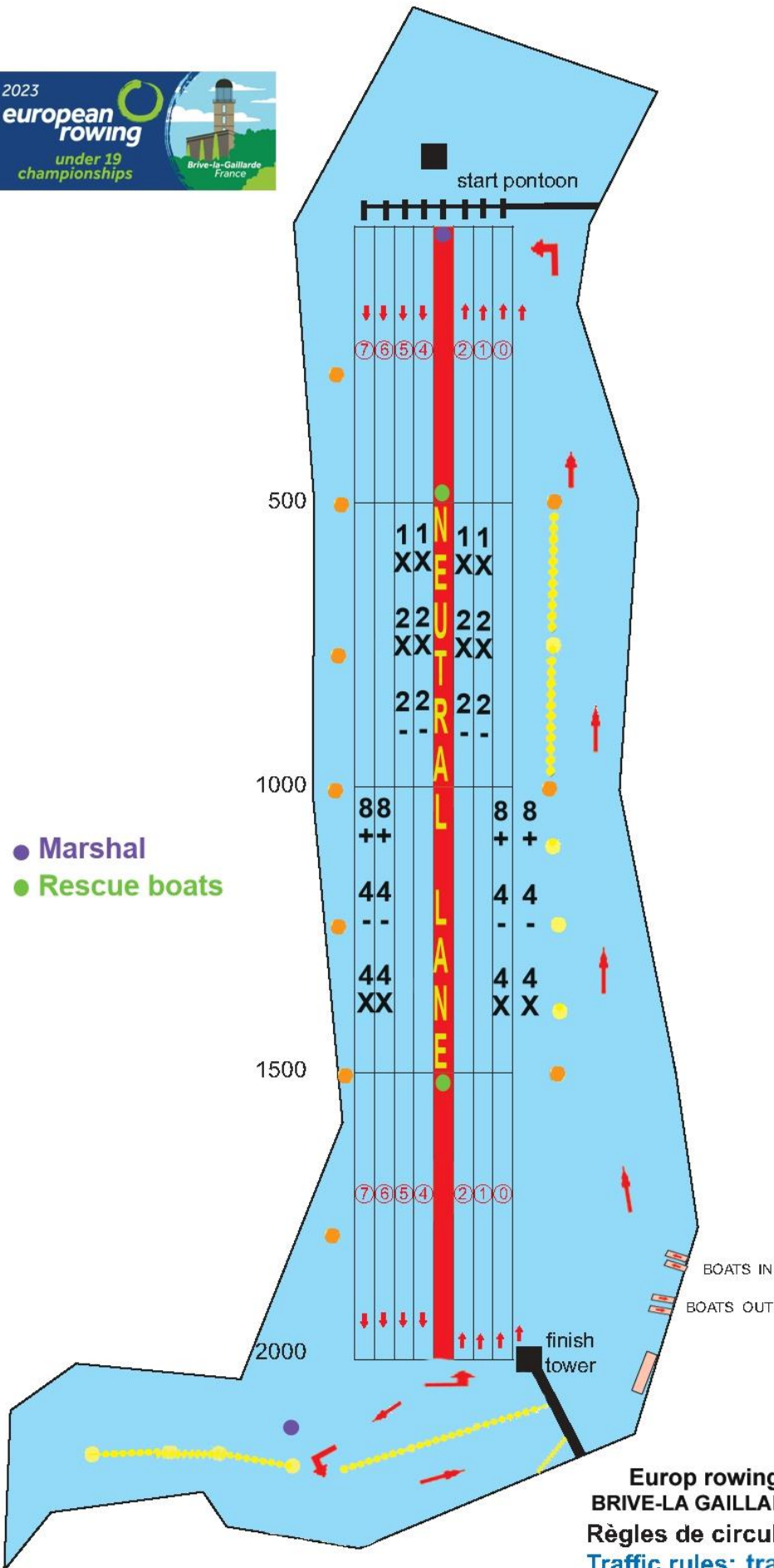
